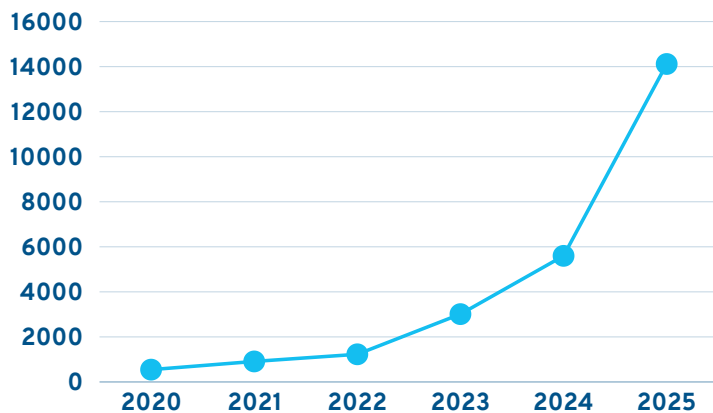

LETTER FROM THE BOARD CHAIR

Gratitude and perseverance are the two words that best define the PREA Foundation's past year. The Foundation is the only organization in the industry that brings together the influence and capital of the institutional real estate community to build the largest and most comprehensive career pipeline into CRE. I am proud of the progress we have made together and energized by our collective responsibility to help shape the next generation.

In 2025, we distributed more funding than ever before, and more than 14,000 individuals have been served through our work. This milestone already surpasses our goal of reaching 10,000 participants by 2028 and underscores the growing reach and scale of the Foundation's work across the CRE workforce.

That momentum was evident throughout PREA's convenings this year. Across the Spring and Fall Conferences, Board members and students shared powerful stories from the mainstage that illustrated the Foundation's expanding impact and its role in shaping career journeys. We honored Yvonne Nelson with the Founder's Circle Award, recognizing her eight years of visionary leadership and lasting impact in expanding access. We were also inspired by a defining moment of generosity when Ambrose Founder and CEO Aasif Bade announced a \$1 million gift following the close of the firm's first institutional fund. This extraordinary commitment reflects the transformative impact our industry can have when leaders invest in advancing opportunity.

This year, we also celebrated Gail Haynes whose leadership and longstanding contributions to the PREA Foundation were recognized through the establishment of the Gail Haynes Scholarship Fund. We are grateful to the many donors who contributed in her honor, as well as to the PREA Foundation Board of Directors for their \$1 million matching commitment. Together, these contributions establish an enduring investment in future generations of CRE professionals.

As we approach our 10-Year Anniversary in 2028, our charge is clear. This moment calls on us to move from momentum to resiliency by deepening long-term investment and creating a sustainable future, while advancing our programs and partnerships.

To our Board, donors, partners, and staff, thank you for your commitment, generosity, and belief in what we can accomplish together. The progress we have made is a direct result of your commitment and collaboration. TREASURER'S REPORT

As Treasurer, I am pleased to report that the PREA Foundation remains on strong financial footing, reflecting disciplined management and continued mission-aligned growth in 2025.

Treasurer's Key Financial Highlights

- **\$4.8M raised** in new and renewed pledges, with the majority structured as five-year commitments.
- **\$3.5M distributed** in grant funding to five talent development organizations, including an additional grantee focused on supporting college students. This investment supports programs that expand access to careers in commercial real estate and reflects a \$500,000 increase over 2024 grant funding.
- **81% program-to-expense ratio**, reflecting the Foundation's commitment to lean operations and maximizing donor dollars.
- **Four-star Charity Navigator rating**, affirming strong governance, transparency, and organizational effectiveness

These results reflect the strength of the Foundation's financial stewardship and the continued confidence of our donors and partners.

In 2025, the PREA Foundation continued its commitment to expanding opportunity and opening doors for the next generation of talent to discover, access, and thrive in our industry.

This year, **we awarded \$3.5 million in grants**—the largest investment in our history—supporting charitable partners and extending our career development programs to nearly **8,000 participants nationwide**. Each grant represents not only financial support, but a belief in the potential of young people to shape the future of commercial real estate.

We were especially proud to launch the **Community Grants Program**, an initiative designed to bring the PREA community closer to the impact of our work. Through this effort, PREA Foundation supporters nominated college-based, student-led real estate clubs, reviewed applications, interviewed finalists, and helped award more than **\$150,000** to empower students, strengthen skills, and accelerate career pathways into the industry.

None of this would be possible without the leadership, generosity, and dedication of our Board, donors and staff. It is a true privilege to work alongside such an inspiring team and to help create life-changing opportunities for the next generation of leaders who will define the future of CRE.

BUILDING THE TALENT PIPELINE

Founded in 2017, the PREA Foundation was established to address the growing need to develop the next generation of CRE talent. Since its founding, the Foundation has built the largest and most comprehensive industry career pipeline through a dual approach:

1. **PREA Foundation grants to leading nonprofit organizations** to create and deliver CRE pathway programs, and
2. **PREA Foundation programs for PREA members** that provide direct industry engagement opportunities.

Institutional Real Estate Career Pipeline



Together, these programs support participants at critical inflection points, from **high school through the C-suite**.

To date, the PREA Foundation has **distributed \$12.6 million in grants** to nonprofit partners who are leading providers of career training programs. Through this work, more than **14,000 participants** have been served.

Honoring a Legacy Through Lasting Opportunity

In 2025, the PREA Foundation proudly honored Gail Haynes for her 30 years of visionary leadership as President of PREA. Her commitment to expanding opportunity has shaped both the institutional real estate community and the mission of the PREA Foundation.

To extend her legacy, the Foundation established the **Gail Haynes Scholarship Fund**. Through the collective generosity of the PREA community, including a \$1 million leadership contribution from PREA, **more than \$2 million was raised to support the fund**. This remarkable show of support reflects the enduring impact of Gail's leadership and a shared commitment to advancing her vision.

The scholarship provides need-based financial support to students participating in summer internships and attending PREA conferences, helping high-potential emerging leaders access the experiences and networks critical to early-career success in commercial real estate.



COMMUNITY GRANTS PROGRAM

\$150,000+ Granted to Student-Led CRE Initiatives

In 2025, the PREA Foundation launched a **new Community Grants Program** to expand access to career opportunities in CRE. Selected student groups were eligible to receive **grants of up to \$10,000 per group** to support initiatives such as site visits, career readiness workshops, case competitions, and the expansion of real estate clubs.

Through the new program, **22 student groups from campuses nationwide received funding**, strengthening early pathways through increased industry exposure and student engagement.

The Foundation is grateful to the Community Grants Design Committee—**Melinda Ellis Evers, Kimberly Adams, Christina Scarlato, and Ellen Young**—for their leadership in shaping and launching this new program.




Community Grants Program Committee

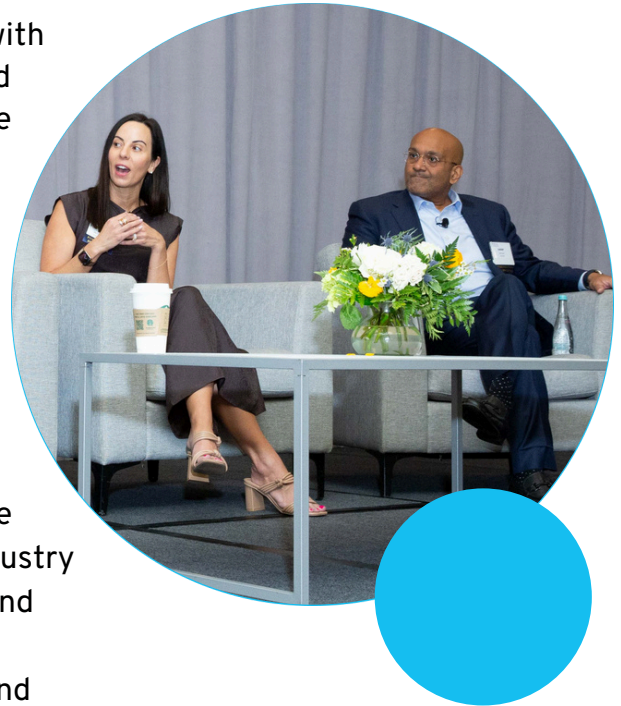
TALENT DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOPS
